A. Call to order

A regular meeting of the Nashua Conservation Commission was called to order on Tuesday, April 19, 2016 at 7:00 PM, in Room 208, City Hall, and Second Floor - 229 Main Street.

Commissioner Cederquist said, at the bottom of page 1, "Commissioner Pierotti" should be changed to "Commissioner Cederquist".

Commissioner Pierotti said, on the middle of page 3, Commissioner Gillespie's comments should be clarified to indicate that only the easterly portion of Old Ridge Road should be removed from the map. He said he also felt that the minutes indicated that the Commission had closed the door on Andrew Morin's farm-to-table idea, which is not how he felt the conversation went.

Chairman Gallagher and Commissioner Dutzy provided clarification to Commissioner Pierotti on the discussion.

Chairman Gallagher said they will need to review their by-laws. The membership term would need to be altered to accommodate having a new student each year.

Commissioner Gillespie said this type of opportunity should be extended to the two other high schools in the City.

Commissioner Gillespie said Nashua High North and Nashua High South never responded to her.

Chairman Gallagher said they will discuss this item of business further at the next meeting.

) Beazer East - Zoning Board
