The City has recently mailed the 2016 December property tax bills. The Real Estate Tax Rate for the calendar year 2016 was set at \$25.07 per thousand.

Most property owners should have received their tax bill on or about November 14, 2016. Anyone who has not received a bill is asked to contact the Tax Office (589-3190). We will promptly provide you with a duplicate copy.

Taxpayers are encouraged to use the mail in service. A paid receipt will be returned in your self-addressed stamped envelope once the collection season has passed. A cancelled check or mortgage statement will also suffice as a receipt for federal tax purposes. Payments can be made at City Hall Monday-Friday, 8:00am to 5:00 pm.

Payments to the City must be postmarked or received by December 16, 2016 in order to avoid the accrual of 12% interest thereafter.
