Subject: Question Regarding Last Year's Drug Court Funding

Hi Carrie,

I hope you are doing great! It's nice to see a lot of the City coming back alive again.

I am writing on behalf of our Drug Court therapist, Julie Christenson-Collins, to ask a question about the CAC funding that the program did not fully spend in FY2020. To refresh your memory, the funds were to start a psychoeducational parenting group for parents with substance use disorder. The funding was to cover the training and salary of two co-facilitators, who would oversee the group and curriculum of 10-12 individuals for 17 sessions. The curriculum is interactive and activities-based and promotes reflective functioning to support effective parenting skills by focusing on the parent-child relationship and interactions.

Unfortunately, due to COVID-19, the project had to be suspended, and so the funds were not spent in entirety. We are wondering if under the unusual circumstances, it would be possible to use that money in FY2021 to continue that project. Has this come up with other agencies?
