ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING PLACING OR BLOWING YARD DEBRIS IN THE STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eighteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 285 “Streets and Sidewalks”, Article IV “General Street and Sidewalk Regulation”, Section 285-28 “Placing snow in street” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 285-28. Placing snow or yard debris in street.

No person shall by himself ~~or~~ or by his agent or agents throw, push, blow or put any snow, ~~or ice,~~ or yard debris, including but not limited to leaves, branches, and grass clippings, into ~~or across~~ the right-of-way of any way, street, lane, ~~or alley,~~ or sidewalk. ~~For the purpose of this section, “right of way” means street and sidewalk. This section shall not apply to the following situations: (i) placement has been directed or requested by the Division of Public Works; or (ii) clean-up or collection of material is simultaneously occurring.~~ Any person who shall violate this section shall upon conviction be subject to punishment as provided in § 1-12.”
