



NASHUA CONSERVATION COMMISSION NOTICE

Site Walk

The Nashua Conservation Commission will conduct a site walk at 111-113 Lock Street to review a proposal to demolish the existing mill building and other structures and construct an 18-unit residential development. Property is located in the 75-foot Prime wetland buffer.

Directions from the North: Follow Main Street and take a left on Canal followed by a left at Chandler. You will pass by a large church on your right. Take a final right onto Lock street. The grassy front lawn will be visible on your right with the existing structures setback from the street. **Directions From the South:** Travel North on Main street take a right onto Canal then a left on Chandler followed by a right on Lock.
