General Meeting Highlights/Notes/Brief Description of Meeting

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Motion to approve DIC December 4th 2020 Minutes by Steve and Michael, motion passed unanimously - Revenue: Parking revenue fell short of \$728,000, this means DIC will not receive funds FY22 which starts on July 1st 2021. The Committee agreed to discuss changing the way DIC receive its funding, i.e either lowering the \$728,000 threshold or a flat fee from parking revenue that will go to DIC. This matter will be discussed with the Alderman and a legislature will be put forward at a later date - Lighting on Main Street: The lights on the trees will be taken down end of February. It will cost \$26,000 to install lights on the trees for all of the winter months - Parking Study: There are currently 9 public meetings scheduled to engage the public about overnight on-street parking. One concern is if overnight on-street parking is enacted City-wide it will cause disruption to businesses - PAC: Notice to proceed to construction has been issued. Construction meetings already started. There will be a meeting for PAC abutters' end of this month. We are expecting heavy construction to take place in March on the PAC and other private developments in the Downtown area are also scheduled to begin in March 2021
