



ORDINANCE

AMENDMENTS REGARDING THE CABLE TELEVISION ADVISORY BOARD (CTAB)

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Six

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article III “Administrative Code”, Division 3 “Administrative Services Division”, Section 2-108 “Cable television advisory board” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language and deleting the struckthrough language as follows:

“Sec. 2-108. Cable television advisory board.

...

(b) Funding for the operation of this committeeCTAB and operation of the municipal access channels shall be allocated from account 505 81034 with the approval and administration of the mayor and the board of aldermen appropriated by the mayor and the board of aldermen from accounts designated for this purpose.

(c) CTAB will consist of fourteen (14) members total. The five (5) members who are appointed by the mayor shall serve for three-year terms. The members are as follows:

...

(11) The city’s cable television program manager mayor or his or her designee

...

(e) “Employees and/or contractors who provide services for the implementation and operation of the municipal access channels will consult with and respond to CTAB requests on functional matters including reports, budgets, technical acquisitions and implementations and other information as requested. They may be required to attend meetings and actively participate on subcommittees. The PEG manager reports to the mayor or his/her designee.”
