



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT AS A NEW DIVISION

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Six

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article III “Administrative Code”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by:

1. In Division 3 “Administrative Services Division”, Sec. 2-107 “Departments”, delete subsection (7) “Information technology department” in its entirety.
2. In Division 3 “Administrative Services Division”, Section 2-106 “Director”, subsection (c), delete the phrase “information technology” in the second sentence.
3. Add a new Division 9 “Information Technology Division”, with the following new sections:

“Sec. 2-175. Director.

The mayor shall appoint an information technology division director, who shall have overall responsibility for the satisfactory performance of the functions and duties assigned to the division. The director shall be responsible to the mayor.

Sec. 2-176. Duties.

The information technology division shall assess the city’s data processing needs and shall develop and implement the data processing capabilities required.”

4. In Division 1 “Generally”, Section 2-72 “Administrative divisions; officers and employees”, subsection (b), add the following new paragraph (6):

“(6) Information technology division”

5. In Division 3 “Administrative Services Division”, Section 2-108 “Cable television advisory board”, subsection (c), paragraph (7), replace the phrase “the manager of the information technology department or his or her designee” with “[t]he director of the information technology division or his or her designee”.
