



ORDINANCE

ADOPTING CERTAIN TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES ON A PORTION OF BROAD STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Six

The City of Nashua ordains that that Chapter 13 “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Traffic Control Devices”, Section 13-46 “Streets with traffic calming measures” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding the following new paragraph in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“Broad Street:

Painted crosswalks, cobblestone rubble bumpouts and painted rumble strips in the shoulder area as well as cautionary lighting and signs located on a portion of Broad Street from a distance of 350 feet west of Hyannis Street to 350 feet east of Majestic Avenue and Natick Street.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
