



ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE GOVERNMENT CHANNEL PROGRAMMING ORDINANCE TO ADD CITY OF NASHUA JOB POSTINGS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Six

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article III “Administrative Code”, Division 3 “Administrative Services Division”, Section 2-109 “Municipal channel programming committee” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by replacing that section with the following new section:

“Sec. 2-109. Government channel programming committee.

(a) There shall be a government channel programming committee, which will consist of a representative of the office of the legislative assistant to the aldermen; a representative of the administrative services division; and a Nashua citizen chosen by the other two members. This committee shall be responsible for government channel programming.

(b) The order of priority of meetings to be shown live, taped, played, and replayed on the government channel shall be as listed below, except that the government channel programming committee can override this order by a two-thirds (2/3) vote:

- Board of Aldermen
- Committee of the Whole/Special Board of Aldermen meetings
- Board of Education
- Budget Review Committee
- Finance Committee
- Planning Board
- Zoning Board of Adjustment
- Planning and Economic Development Committee
- Infrastructure Committee
- Ad Hoc Committees / Pennichuck Water Special Committee
- Board of Public Works
- Personnel and Administrative Affairs Committee
- Human Affairs Committee
- Joint Special School Building Committee
- Nashua Senior High School Building Committee
- Cable Television Advisory Board

(c) The government channel programming committee shall also establish and maintain a procedure to use the government channel to broadcast all job postings that the human resources department deems appropriate for external posting.
