



ORDINANCE

ELIMINATING THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Six

The City of Nashua ordains that the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by the following:

1. In Chapter 13 “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, delete Article II “Traffic Commission”, Sections 13-16 through 13-20 inclusive by deleting the struck-through language as follows:

~~“Sec. 13-16. Membership; compensation.~~

~~(a) The mayor may, subject to the approval of the board of aldermen, appoint a commission to be known as the traffic commission. The commission shall consist of three (3) members. The first commissioner shall be appointed for three (3) years, the second for (2), and the third for one (1) year; and thereafter, as their terms expire, each shall hold office until his successors shall be appointed and qualified. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term.~~

~~(b) The commissioners shall serve without salary.~~

~~Sec. 13-17. Duties.~~

~~The traffic commission shall study and investigate all traffic conditions in the city. It shall also recommend to the appropriate aldermanic committee of necessary legislation for the improvement of traffic conditions within the city, and shall further recommend traffic changes needed for the good of the city.~~

~~Sec. 13-18. Organization.~~

~~The traffic commission shall organize annually in the month of January by the choice of one (1) of its members as chairman. It shall also elect a clerk and any other necessary officers to serve for one (1) year or until their successors are chosen.~~

~~Sec. 13-19. Quorum.~~

~~A majority of the members of the traffic commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business, for the performance of any duty, or for the exercise of any power.”~~

~~Sec. 13-20. Reports.~~

~~The traffic commission shall, at the close of each year, make a detailed report to the board of aldermen of its activities for that year. The report shall be published with the report of other municipal departments.”~~

2. In Chapter 13 “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, Article V “Parking and Stopping”, Division 3 “Parking Meters”, Section 13-245 “Installation of meters; designation of parking spaces; maintenance; elderly parking”, replace the four (4) uses of the phrase “traffic commission” with the phrase “infrastructure committee”.

3. In Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article IV “Officers and Employees”, Division 6 “Conduct Regulations”, Section 2-272 “Designation of special municipal employees”, subsection (2), delete the listing “traffic commission”.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
