



## ORDINANCE

### CLARIFYING BOARD OF ALDERMEN AUTHORITY FOR ANY CONSTRUCTION IN GREELEY PARK

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the year Two-Thousand Six*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article III “Administrative Code”, Division 5 “Public Works Division”, Section 2-136 “Director; duties” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

In Section 2-136 “Director; duties”, paragraph (5), second paragraph, delete the struck-through language and add the new underlined language as follows:

“a. ~~This legislation shall be implemented upon the physical relocation of the recreation department to the proposed Greeley Park addition. There shall be no will be a five-year moratorium on all construction at Greeley Park except for from April 8, 1997. The only exception to this provision will be for the construction~~ approved by a majority of the board of aldermen by ordinance after a public hearing. Construction as used in this section shall be construed broadly, including but not limited to, any new construction of any type of structure, monument and/or renovation or rehabilitation of an existing structure. This subsection is not intended to prohibit the parks and recreation department from repairing, maintaining or otherwise servicing structures fully constructed and operational as of December 31, 2006 ~~April 8, 1997.~~”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
