



ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE APPOINTMENT PROCESS FOR THE POSITION OF DEPUTY CITY CLERK

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article IV “Officers and Employees”, Division 3 “City Clerk”, Section 2-207 “Deputy city clerk”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinance, as amended, be further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“Sec. 2-207. Deputy city clerk.

A deputy city clerk shall be appointed by the mayor in consultation with the city clerk and shall be responsible to the city clerk. ~~The mayor and board of aldermen shall elect a member of the staff of the city clerk, who shall qualify in the same manner as the city clerk to be the deputy city clerk.~~ In case of the city clerk’s absence by reason of sickness, resignation or otherwise, the deputy city clerk shall perform all the duties of the city clerk.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Currently under NRO 2-207, the deputy city clerk must be selected from the staff of the city clerk and be appointed by the mayor and board of aldermen. This ordinance would remove the restrictions on who may be appointed and place responsibility for the appointment with the mayor in consultation with the city clerk.
