



## ORDINANCE

### AMENDING THE CONDUCT REGULATIONS TO RECOGNIZE THE MAYOR'S VETO

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Eight*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article IV “Officers And Employees”, Division 6 “Conduct Regulations”, Section 2-276 “Participation in certain matters in which employee has financial interest”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinance, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

**“Sec. 2-276. Participation in certain matters in which employee has financial interest.**

...

(d) Subsections (a), (b) and (c) shall not apply to the mayor’s veto power under section 47 of the Nashua City Charter. Provided, however, that at the time of exercising those powers the mayor shall file with the board of aldermen and the city clerk a written public disclosure of the nature and circumstances of any financial, personal or pecuniary interest of the type identified in this section.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
