



ORDINANCE

CREATING A ONE-MEMBER BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS LIAISON COMMITTEE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article II “Board of Aldermen”, Section 2-24 “Standing Committees”, subsection (a) (4) “*One-member committees*” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined paragraph:

“Sec. 2-24. Standing committees.

(a) The president shall be chairman ex officio of all standing or special committees of the board of aldermen. He shall appoint aldermen as called for, with the first named being chairman and the second named being vice-chairman, to the following standing committees:

...

(4) *One-member committees*: Board of Health Liaison Committee, who shall be a member of the Human Affairs Committee.

Board of Public Works Liaison Committee.

Board of Fire Commissioners Liaison Committee.

Board of Education Liaison Committee.

Board of Police Commissioners Liaison Committee.

Child Care Liaison Committee.

Hunt Building Board of Trustees Liaison Committee.

Planning Board member who, as defined in Section 16 Planning, shall be a member of the Planning and Economic Development Committee.

One-member committees shall have an alternate member appointed in the same fashion as the regular member.”
