



ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A STOP SIGN ON CIDER LANE AT ITS SOUTHERN INTERSECTION WITH HAMPTON DRIVE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Traffic Control Devices”, Section 13-37 “Stop signs”, subsection (b) of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by:

1. Deleting the following heading and paragraph under “*Hampton Drive*”:

“Hampton Drive:

~~Hampton Drive is hereby designated a stop or through street, and authority is hereby granted for the erection of a stop sign on the southwest corner of Cider Lane at its intersection with Hampton Drive in accordance with the tenor of this chapter.”~~

2. Adding a new paragraph under the new heading “*Cider Lane*” as follows:

“Cider Lane:

Authority is hereby granted for the installation of stop signs on the southeast corners of Cider Lane at both its northern and southern intersection with Hampton Drive.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and installation of the appropriate sign(s).
