Rescheduling Meetings that Fall on Election Days

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Article II “General Provisions”, Section 5-7 “Meetings”, subsection B of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended is hereby amended by adding the new language in italics as follows:

- “B. When the day fixed for any regular meeting falls on a day designated by law as a legal or national holiday *or the day of an election*, the meeting shall be held at the same hour on the next succeeding day not a holiday.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
