



ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation,” Chapter 5 “Administration of Government,” Part 7 “Taxation and Finance”, Article XXVI “Accounts and Warrants”, Section 5-132 “Money received; payment to Treasurer; receipts” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by renaming the section, and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“5-132. Money received; payment to Treasurer; receipts; payment by credit card.

- A. The Treasurer shall give ~~his~~ receipt for all payments of money made to the City treasury to the person making the payment and, within one week, shall file a duplicate in the Chief Financial Officer’s office.
- B. Except as otherwise provided, all officers and agents receiving money on behalf of the City shall pay the money to the Treasurer daily or weekly as required by the Treasurer, shall submit reports to the Treasurer setting out in detail the amounts they have received, and shall file a duplicate of such reports in the Chief Financial Officer’s office.
- C. The Treasurer is authorized, but not required, to accept payment of local taxes, charges generated by the sale of utility services, or other fees by use of a credit card. The city will add to the amount due, in addition to any penalties and interest payable, a service charge for the acceptance of the card. The city, at the time of the billing, shall disclose the amount of the service charge.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

FISCAL NOTE: The intent of this legislation is to allow the city to accept convenience fee based payments so that it incurs no expense, and will use a third party processor for the service. There may be a minimal investment in swipe card readers.

ANALYSIS

New Hampshire RSA 80:52-c states that the legislative body, by ordinance, may authorize the municipality's treasurer or other appropriate municipal official to accept payment of local taxes, charges generated by the sale of utility services, or other fees by use of a credit card. The municipality may add a service charge for the acceptance of the credit card to the amount due, and the municipality must disclose the amount of the service charge at the time of billing.

The financial services division wishes to start accepting credit card payments for some city fees, and so requires this legislation in order for that to take place. The ordinance also makes it clear that the city will add a service charge for the acceptance of the credit card.
