



**ORDINANCE**

**ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF REVERE STREET**

***CITY OF NASHUA***

*In the Year Two Thousand and Ten*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 320-69. **No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Revere Street	South	<del>From Main Street west for a distance of 150 feet</del> <u>Entire length</u> ”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
