



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF REVERE STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 320-69. **No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Name of Street	Side	Location
...		
Revere Street	South	From Main Street west for a distance of 150 feet <u>Entire length</u> ”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
