



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON MAIN STREET IN FRONT OF THE PERSIAN RUG GALLERY BUILDING

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-72 “Handicapped parking”, subsection A of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-72. Handicapped parking.

...

A. The following parking spaces are designated as spaces for the handicapped:

Name of Street	Number of Spaces/Type	Location
<u>Main Street</u>	<u>1</u>	<u>25 feet south of the southernmost exit of 223 Main Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary sign(s).
