



ORDINANCE

ELIMINATING THE INCREASE IN THE MAYOR'S FY2011 SALARY

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 4 “Officers and Employees”, Article XIV “Mayor”, Section 5-61 “Mayoral salary”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 5-61. Mayoral salary.

On July 1 of each following year, the Mayor’s salary shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index – Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. However, for FY2011, the Mayor’s salary shall remain at the same amount as FY2010, and for FY2012, the Mayor’s salary shall be calculated as if the Mayor’s FY2011 salary had been increased by the three year CPI-U average change.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect following its passage.



ORDINANCE

ELIMINATING THE INCREASE IN THE MAYOR'S FY2011 SALARY

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 4 “Officers and Employees”, Article XIV “Mayor”, Section 5-61 “Mayoral salary”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 5-61. Mayoral salary.

On July 1 of each following year, the Mayor’s salary shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index – Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. However for FY2011, the Mayor’s salary shall remain at the same amount as FY2010. For FY2012 the Mayor’s salary shall be calculated on the Mayor’s FY2011 salary based on the three year CPI-U average change.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect following its passage.

FISCAL NOTE: This legislation does not increase the Mayor's FY11 salary from its FY10 level, resulting in a savings of approximately \$2,100 in FY11.

ANALYSIS

This legislation amends the ordinance that sets the Mayor's salary, which normally changes each fiscal year by the prior three year average of changes in the CPI-U. This legislation would freeze the Mayor's FY2011 salary at its FY2010 level, but then increases the Mayor's FY2012 salary to where it would have been if there was no FY2011 freeze.
