



ORDINANCE

REGARDING THE USE OF AMPLIFICATION DEVICES AT THE GREELEY PARK BANDSHELL

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 215 “Parks and Recreation Areas”, Article I “Park and Playground Rules”, Section 215-2.1 “Greeley Park”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and is hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 215-2.1. Greeley Park.

~~Except for Summer Fun events and programs, and any groups or individuals who have applied for future use of the park prior to March 23, 2010, use of Greeley Park shall be limited to non-amplified use.—All existing external amplification devices to be used are not expected to change in status, condition, or place as affixed to the bandshell in its current configuration. No portable electronic amplification devices and speakers are permitted.”~~

This ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

No portable amplification devices and speakers are permitted until such time as the unfinished bandshell is completed.

This ordinance shall become effective November 1, 2010.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
