



## ORDINANCE

### EXTENDING THE TWO-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT ZONE ON AUBURN STREET

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Ten*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II "General Legislation", Chapter 320 "Vehicles and Traffic", Article X "Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking Lot Areas", Section 320-38 "Two-hour parking", subsection F of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is, further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

**"§ 320-38. Two-hour parking.**

...

- F. Parking shall be limited to two hours daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, on the following streets:

Auburn Street	Both	From Charles Street to <del>Locust Street</del> <u>Entire length</u> "

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary signs.
