

## **ORDINANCE**

# EXTENDING THE TWO-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT ZONE ON AUBURN STREET

### CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II "General Legislation", Chapter 320 "Vehicles and Traffic", Article X "Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking Lot Areas", Section 320-38 "Two-hour parking", subsection F of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is, further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

#### "§ 320-38. Two-hour parking.

F. Parking shall be limited to two hours daily, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, on the following streets:

Name of Street Side Location

Auburn Street Both From Charles Street to Locust Street Entire length"

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary signs.
