



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A NO-PARKING ZONE ON BOTH SIDES OF DEPOT ROAD FROM THE HOLLIS TOWN LINE SOUTH 670 FEET TO THE DEAD END

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-69. **No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

<u>Depot Road</u>	<u>Both</u>	<u>From Hollis town line south 670 feet to the dead end.</u> ”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
