



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF PROGRESS AVENUE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eleven

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-62 “No parking between signs where indicated” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-62. No parking between signs where indicated.

...

B. The following shall be “No Parking Between Signs” areas:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Progress Avenue</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>Beginning 75 feet east of the westernmost driveway to 15 Progress Avenue and extending east a distance of 30 feet</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
