



**ORDINANCE**

**CHANGING A NO-PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST HOLLIS STREET NEAR PALM STREET TO A TWO-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT ZONE**

***CITY OF NASHUA***

*In the Year Two Thousand and Twelve*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended as follows:

1. In Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-38 “Two-hour parking”, subsection A, add the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

**“§ 320-38. Two-hour parking.**

A. Parking shall be limited to two hours at all times on the following streets:

<u>West Hollis Street</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>From Palm Street to a point 75 feet west</u>

2. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, add the new underlined language as follows:

**“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
