



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON A PORTION OF THE SOUTH SIDE OF CHARLOTTE AVENUE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twelve

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding the following new entry in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“320-69. No parking on certain streets.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Charlotte Avenue</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>From the western driveway exit from the Charlotte Street School westerly a distance of 150 feet”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary sign(s).
