



ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING YIELD SIGNS ON THE TRAFFIC CIRCLE ALONG NORTH SOUTHWOOD DRIVE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twelve

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-7 “City-maintained yield right-of-way signs”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language:

“320-7. City-maintained yield right-of-way signs.

The following locations shall have yield right-of-way signs maintained by the City:

Location

Southeast corner and northwest corner of the traffic circle along North Southwood Drive”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of installation of the appropriate sign(s).

This legislation authorizes yield signs on the southeast and northwest corners of the traffic circle along North Southwood Drive.






