



## ORDINANCE

### ESTABLISHING A THIRTY-MINUTE PARKING TIME LIMIT ON A PORTION THE WEST SIDE OF LIBERTY STREET

#### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking Lot Areas”, Section 320-36 “Thirty-minute parking” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

**“§ 320-36. Thirty-minute parking.**

No vehicle shall be stationed or remain for a period exceeding 30 minutes on the following streets:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Hours</b>	<b>Location</b>

<u>Liberty Street</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>All</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 50 feet north of Kinsley Street and extending to a point 133 feet north of Kinsley Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
