



## ORDINANCE

### ALLOWING OVERNIGHT ON-STREET PARKING ON OLD HOUSE LANE

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-40 “Twenty-four-hour parking”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding the following new underlined language:

**“320-40. Twenty-four-hour parking.**

**Old House Lane.”**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).


**ANALYSIS**

This legislation allows 24 hour on-street parking on Old House Lane. As a result of the reconstruction of Exit 4 at East Dunstable Road, Old House Lane is a short, dead end street accessible only by way of Tempo Drive. See attached map. The only home on Old House Lane, the oldest house in Nashua, has no driveway and uses the two ends of this street for parking. Due to the limited local traffic and lack of any through traffic, on street parking will not obstruct traffic nor interfere with access by emergency vehicles. The police and fire departments have no objection to this legislation.


