



ORDINANCE

EXTENDING THE TWO-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT ZONE ON THE EAST SIDE OF ELM STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-38 “Two-hour parking” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 320-38. Two-hour parking.

- B. Parking shall be limited to two hours daily, except Sundays and holidays, on the following streets:

Elm Street	East	From Belmont Street to Lake Street to a <u>point 100 feet north of Belmont Street</u> ”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
