



ORDINANCE

CHANGING THE PARKING LOTS IN ZONE 1 TO ZONE II

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XI “Parking Meters”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the underlined language as follows:

1. In Section 320-48 “Parking meter lots”:

“§ 320-48. Parking meter lots.

The following described areas lying within the corporate limits of the City are designated as public parking areas and shall constitute parking meter lots in the listed zones:

A. — Zone I.

- (1) — Garden Street parking lot (north and east of Elm Street parking garage).
- ~~(2) — Factory Street parking lot.~~
- ~~(3) — High Street parking lot.~~
- (4) — Water Street parking lot.

BA. Zone II.

- (1) Railroad Square parking lot.
- (2) Le Parc de Notre Renaissance Francaise parking lot.
- (3) Pearson Avenue parking lot.
- (4) Spring Street parking lot.
- (5) Library parking lot (west half of lot).

- (6) City Hall parking lot (west and south of City Hall, north of Nashua Heritage Rail Trail).
- (7) Garden Street parking lot (north and east of Elm Street parking garage).
- (8) Factory Street parking lot.
- (9) High Street parking lot.
- (10) Water Street parking lot.

CB. Zone III.

- (1) Maple Street parking lot.
- (2) School Street parking lot.
- (3) Library parking lot (east half of lot).
- (4) Elm Street parking garage (street level only).
- (5) High Street parking garage (street level only)."

2. In Section 320-49 "Time limits in parking lots":

"§ 320-49. Time limits in parking lots.

A. Time limits in parking lots shall be as follows:

- (1) ~~In Zone I, from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., daily, except for Sundays, and legal holidays, with a ninety-minute time limit.~~
- (2) ~~In Zone II, from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., daily, except for Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, with a one-hundred-twenty-minute time limit.~~
- (3) ~~In Zone III, from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., daily, except for Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, with no time limit.~~

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective once the meters and pay stations have been reprogrammed and the necessary signs are in place. Until that time, the prior ordinances shall continue to apply.

ANALYSIS

This legislation moves all parking lots currently in zone I to zone II. Currently the four parking lots in zone I have meters that are in effect from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Mondays through Saturdays, have a 90 minute time limit, and cost \$0.25 per 15 minutes. If these four parking lots move to zone II, they will then have meters that are in effect from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Mondays through Fridays, have a 120 minute time limit, and cost \$0.25 per 20 minutes.

This legislation has been recommended by the Downtown Improvements Committee.
