



## ORDINANCE

### ESTABLISHING A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE IN FRONT OF 9 MOUNT PLEASANT STREET

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fourteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-72 “Handicapped parking”, subsection A of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

**“§ 320-72. Handicapped parking.**

A. The following parking spaces are designated as spaces for the handicapped:

<u>Mount Pleasant Street</u>	<u>1/parallel</u>	<u>In front of 9 Mount Pleasant Street, on the north side of the street, the space closest to Manchester Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary sign(s).
