



## ORDINANCE

### ALLOWING RESIDENTS OF MULBERRY STREET TO PURCHASE OVERNIGHT ON-STREET PARKING PERMITS

#### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fourteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II "General Legislation", Chapter 320 "Vehicles and Traffic", Article XIII "Night Parking", Section 320-78.1 "Overnight on-street parking pilot program in designated downtown area" of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

**"320-78.1. Overnight on-street parking pilot program in designated downtown area.**

There shall be a pilot program for on-street overnight parking as described below.

...

- B. On-street overnight parking shall be allowed between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on designated streets only to vehicles with a permit. On-street overnight parking for any time period between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on designated streets without a permit is a violation of § 320-78 and is not allowed.
  - 1. Residents of the streets where overnight parking is permitted will be allowed to purchase an annual permit, with a maximum number of 400 permits to be issued.
    - a. Residents of 13 Main Street are also allowed to purchase permits.
    - b. Residents of Buck Street and Mulberry Street are also allowed to purchase permits.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
