



ORDINANCE

ADDING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON BOWERS STREET EAST OF ARLINGTON STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Name of Street	Side	Location

<u>Bowers Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From Arlington Street to a point 100 feet easterly”</u>

“§ 320-70. No parking certain hours and days.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets during the hours and days indicated:

Name of Street	Side	Hours/Days	Location
...			
<u>Bowers Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m./Monday through Friday, school days</u>	<u>From a point 100 feet east of Arlington Street to a point 650 feet east of Arlington Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or pavement markings.


