



## ORDINANCE

### ESTABLISHING A SUBSTANDARD LIVING CONDITIONS ALDERMANIC SPECIAL COMMITTEE

#### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that in Part I “Administrative Legislation” Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 2 “Board of Aldermen”, Article II “General Provisions”, Section 5-9 “Standing committees”, subsection B of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 5-9. Standing committees.

...

B. The President shall appoint Aldermen as called for, with the first named being Chairman and the second named being Vice Chairman, to the following standing committees:

...

(6) Special committees:

(a) Substandard Living Conditions Special Committee, comprised of three aldermen. This committee is responsible for investigating the living conditions at large residential properties where there may be substandard living conditions, determining whether these conditions violate existing housing and/or health codes, and recommending whether new housing and/or health code provisions should be enacted to protect Nashua residents.”
