Bill Text: **ESTABLISHING A 25 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT ON CONCORD STREET FROM MAIN STREET NORTH TO THE HENRY BURQUE HIGHWAY**

In the Year Two Thousand and Two The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", Article IV "Operation of Motor Vehicles", Division 4 "Speed Limits", Section 13-121 "Speed limit signs", subsection (a)(6) thereof of the revised ordinances of Nashua, as amended, be and is hereby further amended by adding the following street to the twenty-five (25) miles per hour list in the appropriate alphabetical order: "Concord Street – from Main Street north to the Henry Burque Highway " All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and installation of the appropriate signs.
