Bill Text: **ESTABLISHING A TWO-HOUR PARKING ZONE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF BROAD STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH AMHERST STREET WEST TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH PINE HILL AVENUE**

In the Year Two Thousand and Two The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic", Article V "Parking and Stopping", Division 2 "Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas" be amended as follows: 1. In Section 13-218, "Thirty-minute parking", under the heading "Broad Street", delete the following struck-through language, and add the following underlined language: "Broad Street, north and south sides, from the junction of Broad and Amherst Streets westerly to Chautauqua Avenue, daily from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. South side, from Amherst Street west to Jones AvenueCourt, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily" 2. In Section 13-220, "Two-hour parking", subsection (i), under the heading "Broad Street", delete the following struck-through language: "Broad Street, south side, from Jones Avenue west to Chautauqua Avenue North side, from Amherst Street west to the intersection of Chautauqua Avenue" 3. In Section 13-220, "Two-hour parking", add a new subsection (j), as follows: "(j) Parking shall be limited to two (2) hours daily, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, on the following streets: Broad Street, south side, from Jones Court west to Chautauqua Avenue North side, from Amherst Street west to the intersection of Pine Hill Avenue" All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary signs.
