



ORDINANCE

DEFINING THE SCOPE OF THE STATE-OF-THE-CITY ADDRESS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Four

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article II “Board of Aldermen”, Division 1 “Generally”, Section 2-22 “Meetings”, subsection (e) of the Nashua Revised Ordinances be further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“(e) The mayor shall deliver an annual state-of-the-city address before the Board of Aldermen at a meeting of that body held on the third Tuesday of February. The state-of-the-city address shall include the health, welfare and finances of all city divisions and departments. The only business of that meeting shall be the mayor’s address and the provisions of NRO Section 2-38 shall not apply.”
