> In the Year Two Thousand and Three The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 2 "Administration", Article II "Board of Aldermen", Division 1 "Generally", Section 2-24 "Standing committees", of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be further amended by adding the following new subsection: "(d) All standing committees shall include in the order of business a period not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes for the acceptance of orally presented communications and comments from the public or others relative to resolutions, orders, appointments or error or omissions in the minutes or reports of that committee on the agenda for that meeting."
