REQUIRING CELL PHONE RINGERS TO BE TURNED OFF DURING MEETINGS AND HEARINGS

In the Year Two Thousand and Four

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article II “Board of Aldermen”, Division 2 “Rules and Order of Business”, Section 2-55 “Code of conduct” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection (i):

“(i) Cell phone ringers shall be turned off at all times during meetings and hearings.”
