



ORDINANCE

INCLUDING FARMERS' MARKETS UNDER THE DEFINITION OF TEMPORARY FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 9 “Food and Food Service Establishments”, Article I “Establishment health regulations”, Sec. 9-16 “Definitions” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby amended by adding new underlined language as follows:

“Sec. 9-16. Definitions.

The following words and phrases, as used in this article, shall have the meaning given in this section:

...

Temporary food service establishment means any food service establishment which operates at a fixed location for a temporary period of time, not to exceed two (2) weeks, in connection with a fair, carnival, circus, public exhibition or similar transitory gathering. Temporary food service establishment shall include farmers’ markets as defined in NH RSA 21:34-a, V.”
