



ORDINANCE

INCREASING THE PERMIT FEE FOR LANDFILL DISPOSAL FOR RESIDENTIAL NONCOMMERCIAL VEHICLES

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 270 “Solid Waste”, Article III “Sanitary Landfill”, Section 270-8 “Issuance, display of permits”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“Section 270-8. Issuance, display of permits.

...

- C. Passenger vehicles and noncommercial vehicle permits shall not exceed a fee of \$510. Commercial vehicle permits shall not exceed a fee of \$50.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect following its passage.
