**RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua and the Division of Public Health and Community Services are authorized to accept and appropriate \$364,000 from the State of New Hampshire Department of Health & Human Services Department into Special Revenue Account #341-6449 "FY 2010 Emergency Preparedness Grant" for the purpose of continuing the activities of the emergency preparedness and response capacity within the Nashua region. These activities include, but are not limited to hazards emergency planning, managing and updating the City of Nashua's plans and annexes for an emergency response, disease surveillance, early event detection systems and maintaining relationships between first responder agencies, hospitals and health care providers.
