AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ESTABLISH AN INTERNATIONAL DESIGN COMPETITION TO GENERATE NEW IDEAS FOR THE NASHUA MILLYARD AND THE SECTION OF THE BROAD STREET PARKWAY FROM LEDGE AND CENTRAL STREETS TO THE BOILER HOUSE

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua is authorized to establish an International Design Competition for the purpose of generating new ideas for the Nashua Millyard and the section of the Broad Street Parkway from Ledge and Central Streets to the Boiler House; and

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposals will focus on opportunities to enhance this section of the Broad Street Parkway as the gateway into the Millyard and Downtown and that all proposals will be conceptual in nature and not presumed to be the basis for any future design of the Broad Street Parkway; and

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized to appoint members to the competition jury; the jury members shall be comprised of professionals with particular expertise in the areas covered by the scope of the competition; and the jury shall be responsible for soliciting and evaluating proposals and select the winning proposal(s); and

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that submissions for the competition be advisory only; the City shall have no obligation to construct any component of the winning entry or entries.
