AMENDING THE AGENT TO EXPEND ON THE FOUR EXPENDABLE TRUST FUNDS THAT ACCEPT CONTRIBUTIONS FOR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION BY QUADRANT

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eleven

WHEREAS, R-04-63 "Establishing four expendable trust funds for accepting contributions for sidewalk construction and transferring contributions and donations from special revenue accounts" was passed by the Board of Aldermen on June 22, 2004; and

WHEREAS, that resolution established four expendable trust funds pursuant to NH RSA 31:19-a for the purpose of accepting contributions to fund sidewalk construction by quadrant, naming the Board of Aldermen as the agent to expend; and

WHEREAS, the Nashua City Charter gives the Board of Public Works the cognizance, direction and full control of the construction, alteration and repair of sidewalks (Charter § 60);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, *by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua* that the agent to expend for these four expendable trust funds for sidewalk contributions be changed from the Board of Aldermen to the Board of Public Works.
