



RESOLUTION

REGARDING A SUN CANOPY FOR THE ROBY PARK PLAYGROUND

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen

WHEREAS, the playground equipment at Roby Park gets extremely hot under direct sun during the summer months, thus limiting its use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that a seasonal sun canopy or other sun shade system should be installed over the Roby Park playground; and

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the city request that the Morin Family consider using Jeff Morin memorial funds to cover the cost of such a sun canopy.

ANALYSIS

This legislation proposes a seasonal sun canopy or other sun shade system over the Roby Park playground to increase the ability to use the playground during the summer, and requests that the City ask the Morin Family to consider using Jeff Morin memorial funds to cover the cost of such a canopy.

This legislation should be referred to the Board of Public Works.
