ANALYSIS

This resolution authorizes the City of Nashua to accept the donation of 7 new Motorola APX 7000 700/800 Dual Band portable radios with a value of \$32,929.68 from the State of New Hampshire. The state was able to use U.S. Department of Homeland Security Grant Program funds to purchase these radios on behalf of the city.

This resolution is a supplemental third disbursement of radios ("Part III"). The City accepted two prior disbursements of radios under R-12-045 (65 radios) and R-12-086 (14 radios) from the State under this same grant program.
